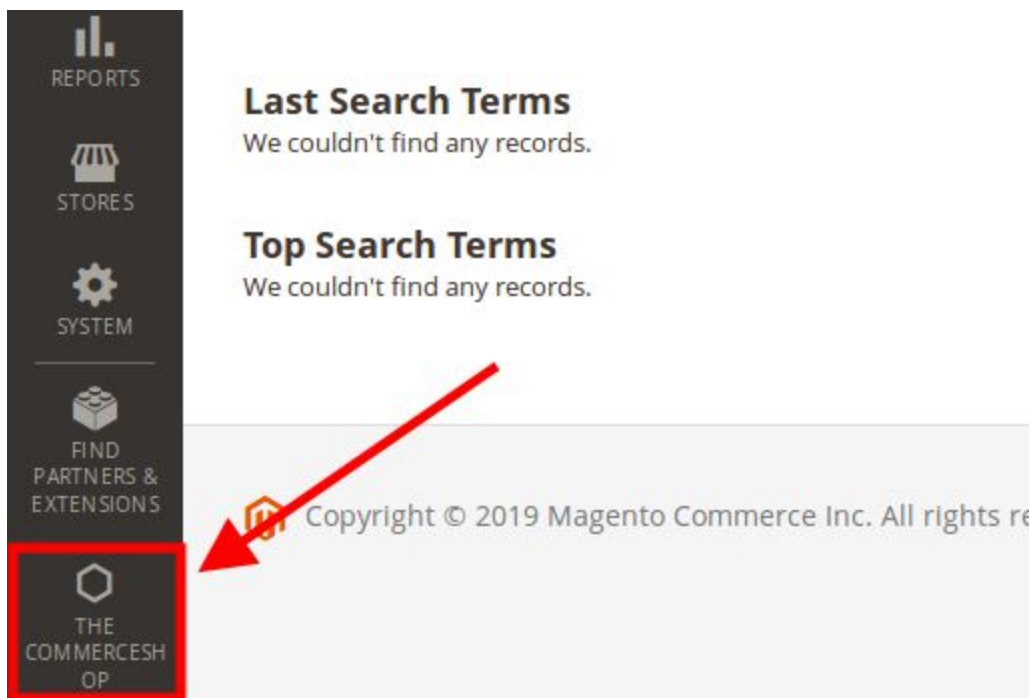
1. Copy paste file in corresponding folder app/code/

2. Setup Upgrade by using the following cmd in terminal

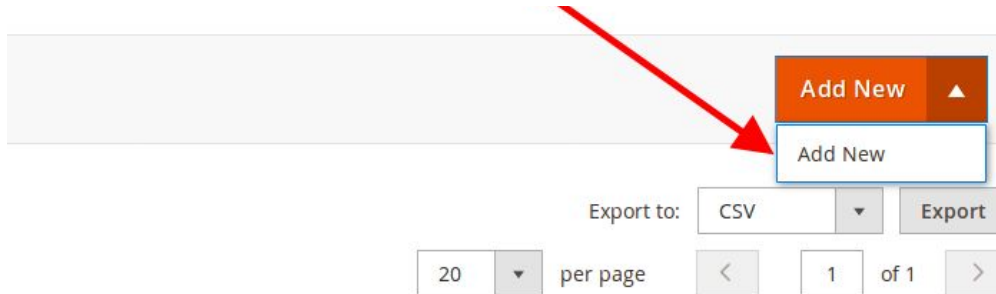
php bin/magento setup:upgrade and provide respective permission for the folder
